Somewhere not far from here there is a big power plant that generates electricity, and all over it are signs that say, "Danger: High Voltage," and "Danger: No Trespassing." Inside is far more power than we could ever need or use. Do you know what would happen if we hooked up a big electrical line at the plant, ran it to the church, flipped a switch and turned it on? There would be a "bzzzzz" and a puff of smoke, and nothing left at 413 West Main Street but a big black hole. That plant has far more power than we ever need or want at one time. But knowing that, the engineers built into the system something called a transformer, which takes all that power and breaks it into meaningful, useful units of electricity that are just what we need. As Tony Evans points out, the Holy Spirit is the Great Transformer. He takes all the majestic truth and power of God and dispenses it in the way you need it at the moment. It is His delight to take the full truth of God, and make one thing meaningful to me over here, another insightful to you over there, and yet another helpful to you back there. He dispenses it as we need it, for conviction, comfort, inspiration, or quidance, and He never makes a mistake. He gives you what you need and what you can handle. Learn to listen to Him—"That good thing which was committed to you, keep by the Holy Spirit who dwells in us" (II Tim 1: 14).

This Sunday morning we will return to the study of Revelation we began a few Sundays back. In introducing Revelation, so far we've looked at who wrote it, when, where, and why, and at some of the adventures and misadventures in interpreting it down through the ages. This week, we'll look at one more introductory matter before we move into the text itself—the cost for being faithful faced by the people in the seven churches John writes to. On Sunday night, we'll look at what happens when the Holy Spirit comes—the results on that Day of Pentecost in Acts 2, and the results in our lives today. Now what could possibly be more important than being present in worship on the Lord's Day?






